

Entrance Test for Nursing 2012

The entrance test for the Nursing Program for 2012 will be **Kaplan**.

The test contains 91 questions divided into 4 sub categories

Reading Section – 22 Questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Writing Section – 21 questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Math Section – 28 questions to be answered in 45 minutes

Science Section – 20 questions to be answered in 30 minutes

Suggested text for preparation: (available at local bookstores and Amazon.com for \$13-\$15). Kaplan Nursing School Entrance Exams (text only).

Testing Process

All tests will be at the Carson Campus, Cedar Room 331D from 1:30P – 4:15P. Applicants need to arrive 15 minutes prior to the test and bring a picture id. There will be a \$25.00 administrative fee. Applicants must fill out the form entitled **Entrance Test for Nursing 2012** found on the nursing website and take it to the business office on the Carson Campus. A copy of the receipt of payment must be presented to the office of Nursing and Allied Health, Cedar Room 104 (lockeym@wnc.edu) to secure a place in the test. Applicants may take the test only once per semester.

Test Dates

Tests will be held on Friday: Jan 27, Feb 3, Feb 10, Feb 17, Feb 24, Mar 2, Mar 9, Mar 16, Mar 30, with a maximum of 20 applicants in each test. Sign-ups start on Monday Dec 5, 2011 and applicants are encouraged to sign up early to obtain a place as dates will fill up (775 445-3294.) Registration for each test will close 7 working days before the test. There will be no refunds or cancellations after that date. Requests for refunds will not be processed until after April 2, 2012.

Eligibility Criteria

Points will be awarded as follows

50% – 59%	0 points but eligible to be considered for admission
60% - 69%	1 point
70% - 79%	2 points
80% - 89%	3 points
90% - 99%	4 points

Applicants must achieve a minimum score of 50% or more in each sub category in order to be considered for admission.
