

WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE (WUE) APPLICATION

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program coordinated by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students from participating western states may apply to enroll in college programs at a reduced tuition level of 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. The following states participate in WUE: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, Wyoming.

Only new students who have not matriculated to WNC may apply for WUE status. To qualify a student must have maintained a legal bona fide resident status in an approved WUE state for at least twelve months prior to the first day of the semester of application. An applicant must also be a U.S. citizen or Resident Alien. Applicants must submit a driver's license or I.D. card issued at least twelve months prior to the semester start date and evidence of one year of consecutive physical residence in the WUE state (examples of evidence include a lease agreement, rent receipts, utility bills, copy of student's vehicle or voter registration, high school transcript).

This application and supporting documents must be received by WNC Admissions & Records no later than 2 weeks after the first day of instruction of the applicable semester. It is highly recommended this application be submitted at least one week prior to the first day of instruction of the applicable semester.

Students who are approved for WUE status and enroll may not be reclassified as a Nevada resident until the student disenrolls from WUE and pays full nonresident tuition for at least 12 months from reclassification to resident status. WNC reserves the right to limit the number of WUE students from each state.
