V. Agreement

This document is an agreement with Western Nevada College for GBC students for course transferability. Students are responsible for understanding catalog years. This agreement is valid for the catalog year listed for students who either

- a) complete their first transfer course at GBC during the academic catalog year listed on this agreement and finish all degree requirements within 10 years of completion of their first GBC transfer course, or
- b) transfer to WNC during the academic catalog year of this agreement and finish all degree requirements within 10 years of transfer.

Note: GBC students who completed their first transfer course prior to fall 2007 may use the 2007-08 transfer agreement as 2007-08 catalog is the first year the BTECH in Construction Management program was offered, provided they finish all degree requirements by summer 2018.
