**EXCELSIOR COLLEGE COURSEWORK**

For this program 30.00 credits are required at upper level. A minimum of 21.00 credits must be in arts & sciences. An additional 9.00 credits can be in any academic area. Since some criminal justice courses are classified as arts & sciences while other are considered electives, remaining upper level requirements will depend on the classification of the 15.00 credits actually taken for the major.

**Note on Depth Requirement**

This program requires two depth areas. A depth consists of 12 credits in one academic discipline, of which 3 hours must be upper level. One depth must be in the arts & sciences. The second depth can be in any academic area. Completing the criminal justice major will account for the second depth. Excelsior recommends that the first depth be completed in a complimentary criminal justice subject, such as **Political Science, Psychology** or **Sociology**. Students should complete up to 9.0 credits at WNC in one of these subject areas as part of their remaining lower level degree requirements.

This transfer guide is provided for informational purposes only and does not guarantee requirements to complete degree. Requirements will be based on actual coursework taken by any individual student.

Excelsior puts no limit on the number of credits a student can transfer as long as that of credit meets degree requirements and comes from a recognized source. Therefore, any credit completed in addition to those pursued with WNC will be considered for transfer. However, as part of the Excelsior/WNC partnership, students are required to take a minimum of 12 credits in Excelsior College coursework.

The first step in becoming an Excelsior College student is to apply by submitting an Undergraduate Application, which requires the inclusion of all official transcripts of prior college credits. Once an application is reviewed, an evaluation summary outlining what is still needed to complete this degree will be provided to the student.
