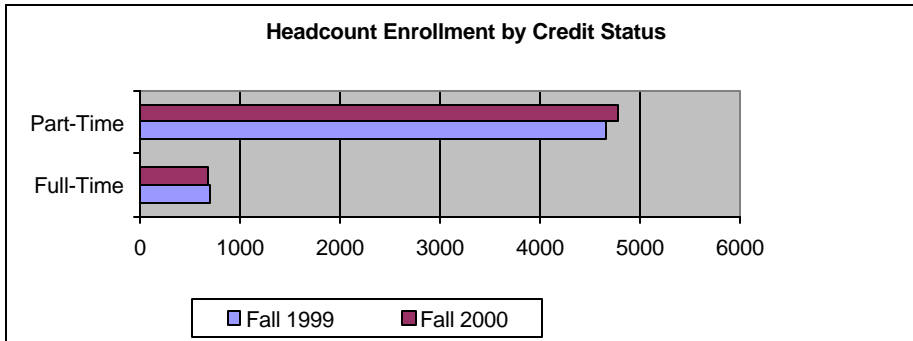
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1 Student Access

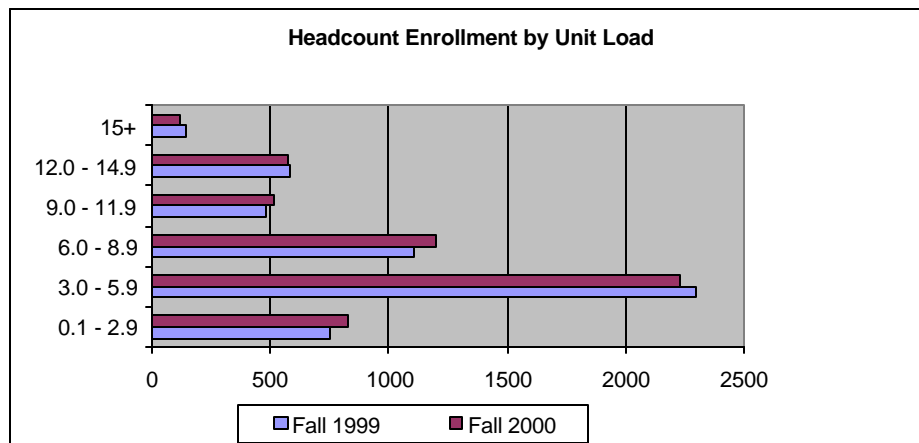

Analysis: The ratio of full-time to part-time students remained about the same.

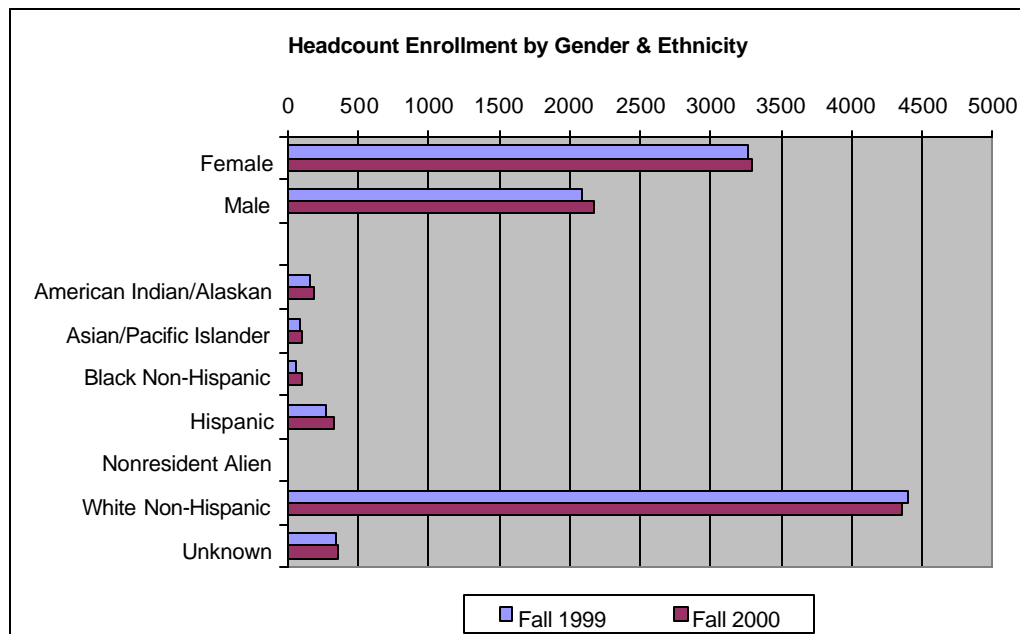

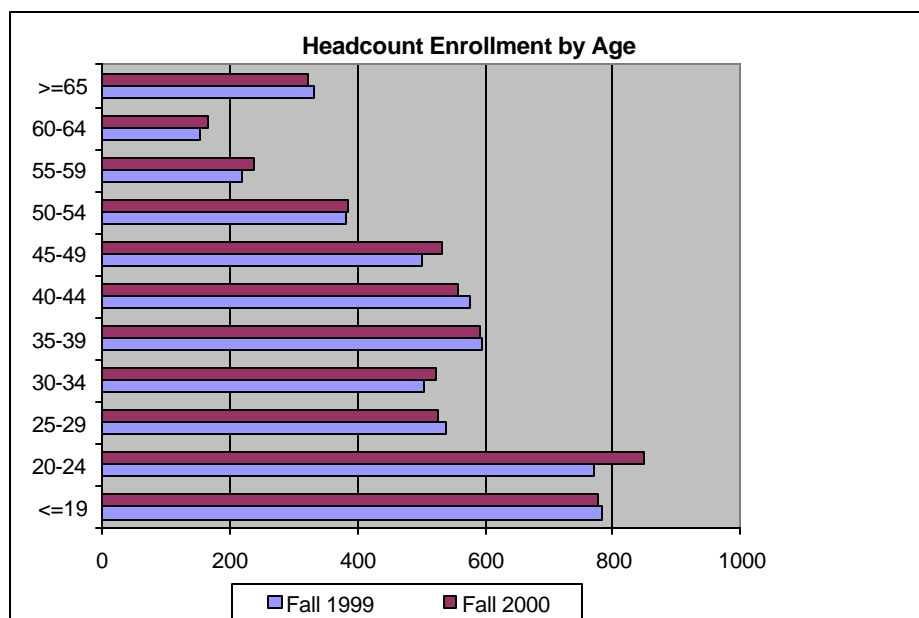

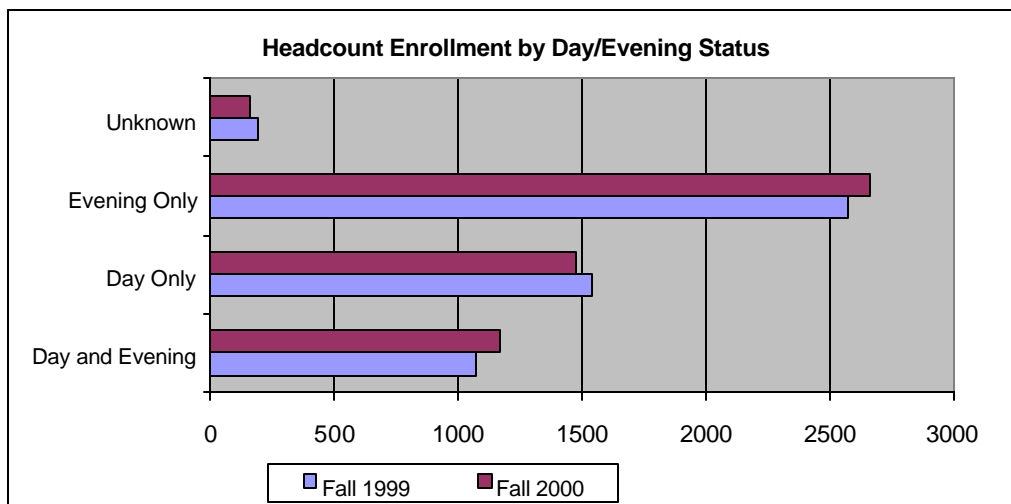

This measure shows the level of student participation by the time of day classes are attended. It also illustrates the institutional effort to offer instruction to nontraditional students during evening hours.

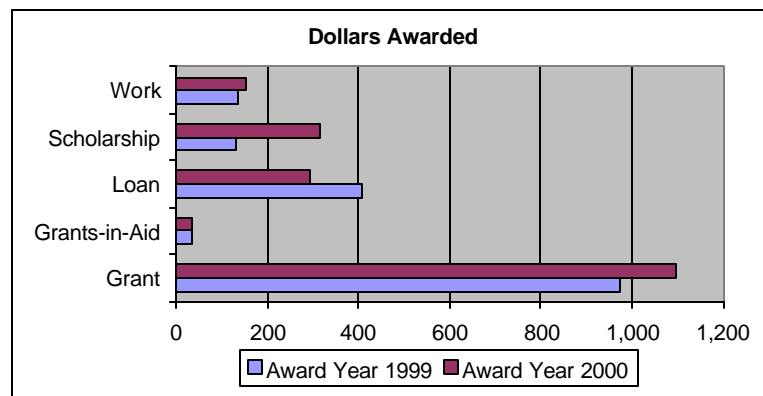
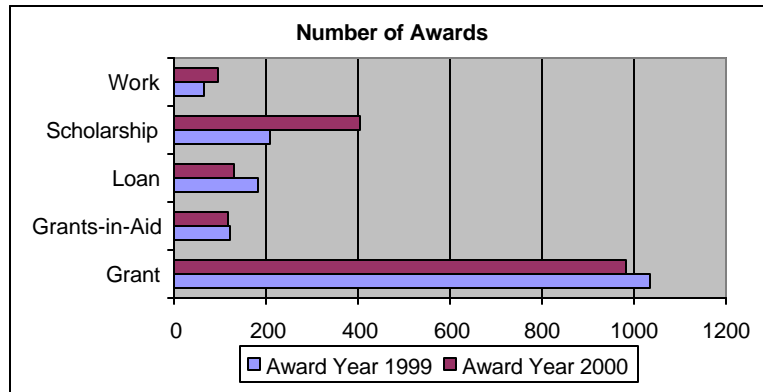

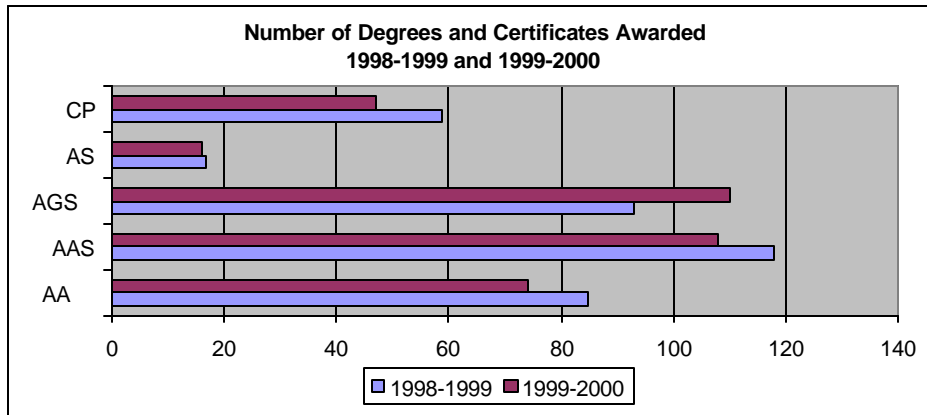

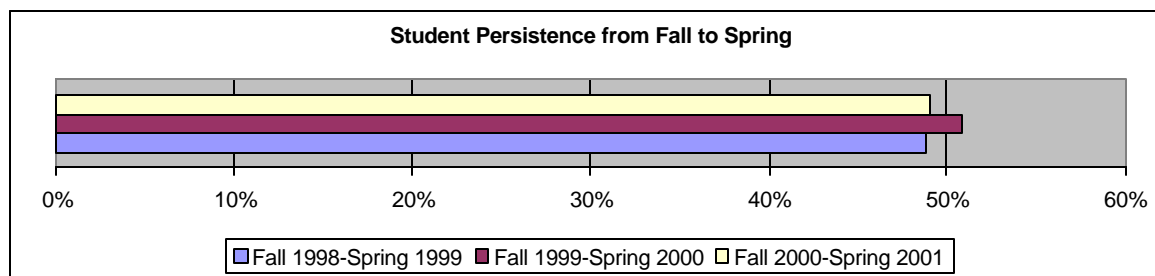

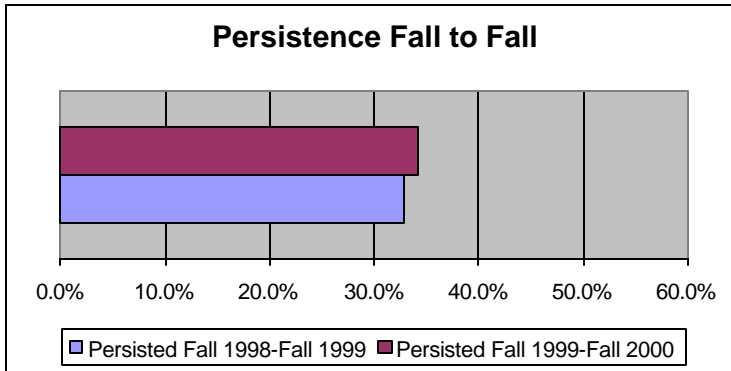

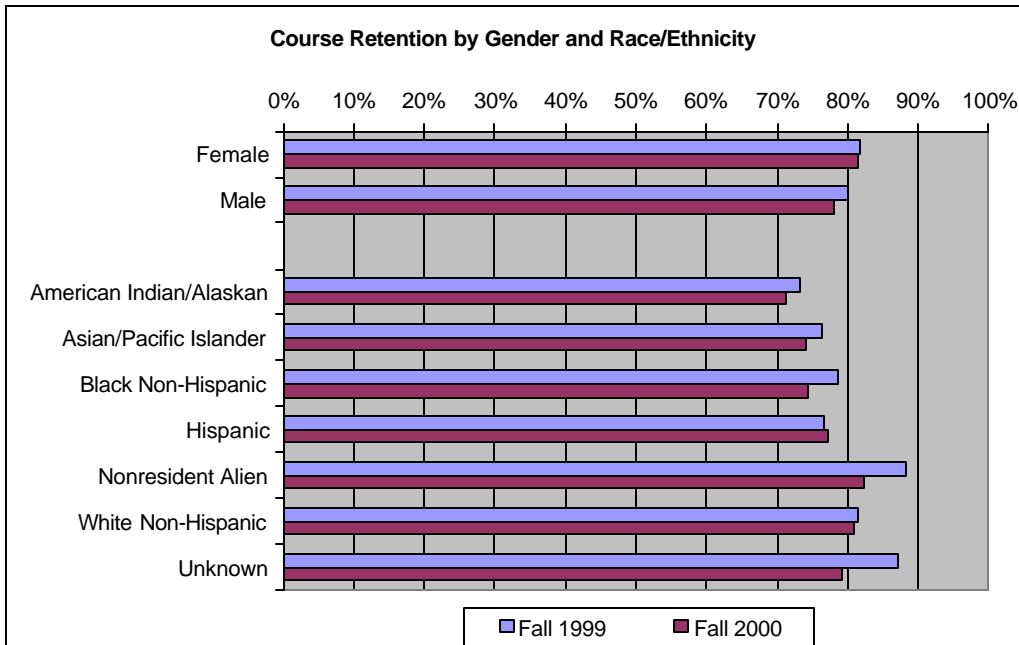
