VI. Additional Comments

Students who receive an Associate of Applied Science degree in Building Technology with a Construction Management emphasis from College of Southern Nevada will have all lower division construction core requirements completed, including AC 198B, BI 101B, CADD 100, CONS 108B, 114B, 116B, 118B, 120B, 121B, 205B, 216B, 230B, 281B, and SUR 161.

Students must earn a minimum of 128 credits, 40 or more of which must be earned in upper division coursework courses numbered 300 or above. A minimum of 32 credits residence credits must be taken at Western Nevada Community College. Student must maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

VII. Agreement

This document is an agreement with Western Nevada Community College for CSN students for course transferability. Students are responsible for understanding catalog years. This agreement is valid for the catalog year listed for students who either
 a) complete their first transfer course at CSN during the academic catalog year listed on this agreement and finish all degree requirements within 10 years of completion of their first CSN transfer course, or
 b) transfer to WNC during the academic catalog year of this agreement and finish all degree requirements within 10 years of transfer.

Note: CSN students who completed their first transfer course prior to fall 2007 may use the 2007-08 transfer agreement as 2007-08 catalog is the first year the BTECH in Construction Management program was offered, provided they finish all degree requirements by summer 2018.
