Notes on Methodology: First-time students are those enrolled in college for the first time after graduating from high school. Graduation rates are completions within 150% of normal time -- an industry skills certificate within one year, a certificate of achievement within 1 1/2 years, an associate's degree within three years or a bachelor's degree within six years. Transfer out rates are calculated for the same time period for only those students who did not graduate. This information is reported to the Federal IPEDS Survey and is current as of 2017-18.
