Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) #1 – Required to enroll (1)	
Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) #2 one month after #1 – Required to enroll	
Hepatitis B #1 (Hepb 1) – Required to enroll	
Hepatitis B #2 (Hepb 2) – one month after #1 - Required to enroll	
Hepatitis B #3 (Hepb 3) – 4-6 months after #1 - may be in progress	
PPD-TB (Tuberculosis Test) 1 st step – Required to enroll (2)	
PPD-TB (Tuberculosis Test) 2 nd step – Required to enroll	
BLS (Basic Life Support CPR) Acceptable cards: American Heart Association BLS or American Red Cross BLS Healthcare Provider. No other cards will be accepted – Required to enroll	
Tetanus (TDAP or DTAP preferred)	
Major Medical Insurance – Required to enroll (3)	
Varicella (chickenpox) #1– Required to enroll (4)	
Varicella (chickenpox) #2 – one month after #1– Required to enroll	
EMT Certificate – must be registered as a Nationally Registered Emergency Medical Technician with the last 2 years	
Flu Immunization: will be required by October 1 st for Fall and Prior to enrollment of the Spring Semester. (Not required for Summer)	

(1) MMR not required if born before January 1957

(2) A two-step TB skin test is one test in each arm approximately 10 days apart; readings must be done 48-72 hours after the test in both cases. You may also submit two consecutive years of negative readings. PPD-TB skin tests must cover the duration of the course. TB must be updated annually.

(3) Short term major medical insurance must cover the duration of the course.

(4) Titers (blood draw) are also accepted.

These documents must be submitted through mystudentcheck.com in order to enroll. Any student becoming non-compliant with these requirements during the semester will not be permitted to participate in Labs or Clinicals.
