Acknowledgements:

Students/Parents must reimburse the high school for college classes in which they receive a W or an F including the cost of college credits and lab fees. Students are responsible for attending all college class meetings and must maintain current contact information in myWNC. Students are given more freedom and are expected to be responsible, mature and self-motivated. Students may be exposed to adult material, subject matter, and language. Students are required to attend all high school and JumpStart College classes and all meetings associated with the JumpStart college entrance process. Student's Right to Fail:

Students and parents acknowledge that if students drop, fail or withdraw from courses, don't complete required course work, or don't inform the high school counselor immediately if they're not doing well in a class, the student could be in jeopardy of NOT graduating from high school.

Western Nevada College Jump Start College maintains a "Guided Pathways to Success" Program to review student progress and monitor those who have difficulties while attending WNC. The first priority is to provide assistance; however, students may not be allowed to continue in the program if, despite help, they earn any grade of D or F, or demonstrate behavior or attendance problems in college classes.

Authorization to Release Records

In accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, neither Western Nevada College (WNC) nor the high school will disclose non-directory information from a student's education records without the written consent of the student. Students under age 18 in the Jump Start program must have written permission from his/her parent/guardian. I give permission for WNC and my high school to disclose, each to the other, for the purpose of dual enrollment, all information in my educational records, including but not limited to test results, college placement test results, class schedule information, attendance, grades, GPA, and transcripts necessary or desirable for the undersigned student's participation in the Jump Start College Program offered by my high school and WNC. As a student, I further give permission for WNC and my high school to disclose all information in my education records to my parent/guardian.

Jump Start students are required to complete this form at the start of their Jump Start program. This form will remain valid throughout their high school career.
