Foundation Profile

The Foundation has offered programs benefiting Western Nevada employees and students since 1992. These programs include instructional equipment, program support, and scholarships.

- During the 2013 14 Academic Year, 120 students continued their education at WNC with the help of a Foundation scholarship. The total amount awarded exceeded \$165,000.
- WNC Employees donate over \$30,000 per year to scholarships and programs.
- The WNC Foundation's financial net position totals over \$3.1
 million with an average of 8% 10% growth per year.
- The Foundation raised \$971,000 in scholarships, program support and investment returns in 2014.

Ways to Invest

Cash Investment

Planned Gifts
