Comments/Information	 Desirae, Addison, agree that \$5000 is a too high amount to fund this event, and that \$1500 would be more appropriate. Desirae and Benjamin agree that the ASWN's funds should be spent on students already enrolled, not potential students. Heather stated that having a Treasurer would be very helpful to keeping track of the budget. Gabrielle stated that is better to be safe with the budget and vote on a lower amount to fund the event. Heather stated that the Nevada Promise event could have upwards of 600 non WNC students attend the event, and that the counseling office has very little funds on their own. Heather continued with stating that the Nevada Promise event has been fairly successful in the past, and that it is important to consider what effect the rest of the year's expenditures will have on the ASWN's budget. Heather understands that \$5000 is very high, but also wants the ASWN to know the importance that this event is well funded. Benjamin stated that he remembered an amount being approved fund the Nevada Promise event last year. To her surprise, Heather did not recall this being the case. Benjamin corrected himself, and stated that he remembered the ASWN's involvement, but not funding. Gabrielle brought up that in order to qualify for the Nevada Promise scholarship community service is required, and that those hours could be spent volunteering for the ASWN, increasing the benefits for having a table at the event. Desirae proposed that any amount funded would be beneficial for the event to be a success, and that \$1000 was a fitting amount in her opinion. Addison agreed with this statement.
