Health Documents

Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) #1 – Required to enroll (See items 1 & 3 below)	
Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) #2 - One month after #1 – Required to enroll	
Hepatitis B (HepB) #1 – Required to enroll (See item 3 below)	
Hepatitis B (HepB) #2 – One month after #1 - Required to enroll	
Hepatitis B (HepB) #3 – 4-6 months after #1 - May be in progress	
TB (Tuberculosis Test, PPD) 1st step – Required to enroll (See item 2 below)	
TB (Tuberculosis Test, PPD) 2nd step – Required to enroll	
Tetanus (TDAP or DTAP preferred) - Must be within 10 years	
Varicella (Chickenpox) #1– Required to enroll (See item 3 below)	
Varicella (Chickenpox) #2 – One month after #1– Required to enroll	
Influenza Vaccine: Will be required by October 1 st for Fall Semester and prior to enrollment in the Spring Semester. (Not required for Summer)	
BLS (Basic Life Support) CPR Card: American Heart Association BLS for Healthcare Providers. <i>No other cards will be accepted</i> – Required to enroll	
Major Medical Insurance – Required to enroll (See item 4 below)	

Background Check Documents *Select Background Check (and Immunization) boxes*

Background check through mystudentcheck.com . Results take 5-10 days; returned directly to the Nursing & Allied Health office. Due not later than day 5 of semester start	
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Drug Screen

Nine panel drug screen – Obtain form via email: nursing.alliedhealth@wnc.edu Results will be returned directly to the Nursing & Allied Health office	
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1. MMR not required if born before January 1957. Titers are also accepted.
2. A two-step TB skin test is one test in each arm approximately 10 days apart; readings must be done 48-72 hours after the test in both cases. You may also submit two consecutive years of negative readings, no more than 52 weeks apart. PPD-TB skin tests must cover the duration of the course. TB must be updated annually or two-step will again be required.
3. Titers (blood draw) are also accepted for MMR, Hep B, TB, and Varicella. If titer results in non-immune, a booster vaccine must be submitted after the titer date.
4. Short-term major-medical insurance must cover the duration of the course.

Students must submit immunization, health insurance, etc. (Health) documents through mystudentcheck.com in order to enroll, and authorize Background Check. Any student becoming non-compliant with these requirements during the semester will not be permitted to participate in Labs or Clinicals.
