

SP20 Transition to Online Instruction and Student Services Survey Results

Executive Summary of Results

Population Surveyed: All enrolled SP20 WNC students as of May 2020 (excluding Prison Education) (3292 students)

Survey Open: 05/05-05/17/20

Response Rate:

- 12% (392/3292) Complete Response
- 14% (470/3292) at least Partial Response
- Note on response rate: Due to the low response rate of this survey, these results should be viewed as representative only of the participating student respondents. This survey was conducted at the end of a challenging semester and without the benefit of incentive prizes and on-campus promotion, which may have contributed to the lower response rate.

Result Highlights:

- 69% (322/470) of respondents were enrolled in or had previously taken at least one online course prior to the March 2020 transition.
- 84% (368/440) of respondents were still able to participate in all of their classes following the March 2020 transition.
 - Of the 16% (72/440) who said they were not able to participate in all classes, top cited reasons were:
 - Class was a lab or other hands-on course: 38% (27/72)
 - Difficult to get the most out of class in an online format: 33% (24/72)
- How satisfied were students with their courses that transitioned to online instruction?
 - 61% (268/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with support from instructors.
 - 60% (265/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with the availability of instructors.
 - 58% (256/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with feedback from instructors on homework, quizzes, and/or exams.
 - 55% (243/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with use of technology.
 - 51% (224/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with interaction with instructors.
 - 35% (155/440) of respondents were highly satisfied or satisfied with interaction with classmates.
 - 46% (203/440) of respondents were overall highly satisfied or satisfied with their courses that transitioned to online instruction.

- Did students have access to the academic resources they needed to be successful? Students selected all that applied:
 - 36% (154/422) of respondents reported needing more contact with instructor(s).
 - 29% (122/422) of respondents reported needing more contact with other students.
 - 19% (80/422) of respondents reported needing more access to the library's resources.
 - 37% (156/422) of respondents reported that they did not need additional access to academic resources.

- Did students have access to the physical resources they needed for classes and accessing student services? Students selected all that applied:
 - 24% (94/397) of respondents reported they did not have a quiet or consistent study space.
 - 12% (49/397) of respondents reported they did not have reliable internet access.
 - 9% (35/397) of respondents reported they have limited access to a computer.
 - 61% (242/397) of respondents reported they had access to the physical resources they needed.

- Of respondents who reported using student services such as Counseling, Financial Aid, and others, 65% (137/210) reported that the quality of student services has stayed the same or improved since the transition, and 57% (117/205) reported that the availability of student services has stayed the same or improved since the transition.


- The top question respondents had regarding the upcoming summer and fall semesters is whether in-person classes will resume (63% or 249/397).

- What do students wish WNC faculty and staff knew about what they're going through? Students selected all that apply:
 - 50% (197/392) of respondents said it's hard to learn and do schoolwork from home.
 - 41% (162/392) of respondents said they miss interacting with their classmates.
 - 40% (158/392) of respondents said that after the transition to online instruction, they felt like they're on their own in some classes.
 - 31% (121/392) of respondents said they had an increase in the amount of classwork.

Q1 For the Spring 2020 semester, are you currently a full-time or part-time student?



Q2 Had you participated in online classes prior to the March 2020 transition to online instruction?




Q3 What is your age range?









Q13 Overall, how has the quality of student services changed since the March 2020 transition to online services?



Q14 Overall, how has the availability of student services changed since the March 2020 transition to online services?




