Applications will be reviewed upon submittal. Students may apply **each semester** as funding is available. Summer session will be funded if there are still available funds.

You will be notified by mail if your application has been accepted. <u>Failure to thoroughly complete every portion of this application may result in automatic denial of your request for funds.</u>

The following costs will be covered as approved and in the order presented:

<u>Textbooks and required special program supplies:</u> Present a bonafide receipt or statement for reimbursement.

<u>Childcare:</u> A childcare provider form <u>may</u> need to be completed. The Perkins grant manager will verify the provider. Students will be required to submit a bonafide receipt for reimbursement. <u>Transportation:</u> Gasoline only - costs will be calculated and capped based on mileage charts and class schedule. Student will present bonafide gas receipts for reimbursement.

As a recipient of the P.E.G. Grant, you must:

- *complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every school year. Exceptions can be made at the discretion of the Perkins Grant Manager. Students who have not completed a FAFSA must supply a statement of financial need.
- * maintain a minimum grade point cumulative average (GPA) of 2.0 with a completion rate of 67% and for continuing students, show academic progress toward completion of chosen degree or certificate.
- * Immediately inform this office at 445-3305 of any changes in name, address, phone, and marital status.

Please keep information current on your MyWNC account, and at the Grants office.

Students may be required to take the English, Math and Reading placement exams

Low Income Special Populations Definitions

Displaced homemaker:

- a.) Is not employed or has less than full-time or adequate employment and
- b.) Has worked at home for a substantial number of years providing household services to member of the family without compensation **and**
- c.) Has difficulty securing employment adequate for economic independence; and
- d.) Has been dependent:
 - 1.) On the income of another member of the family but is no longer supported by that income
 - 2.) Upon public assistance but is no longer eligible; or
 - 3.) On another member of the family for the management of personal finances but that person is no longer available to provide that assistance
- e.) Have documented unmet need

• Single Parent:

- a.) Has custody and supports one or more children
- b.) Is a single woman who is pregnant (bring documentation of due date)
- c.) Have documented unmet need
