- 3. If you received aid for classes you were originally enrolled and they were applicable to your declared degree/certificate, and later make adjustments to classes that do not apply to your degree/certificate, you will be liable to *repay aid* that was disbursed to you.
- **4.** The total estimated Cost of Attendance shown on your offer letter is a projection of overall costs you may incur for the academic year. **Please note:** your actual cost of attendance may vary depending upon enrolled credit hours, program specifications, lab fees and consumer lifestyle choices.
- **5.** Important information about your financial aid offers are included in the Message Codes section at the bottom of this offer letter.
- **6.** Review your "To Do List" frequently for any outstanding items.
- 7. WNC Financial Assistance Office will begin disbursing Grants and Scholarship the week prior to the first day of classes. Refunds will be sent from the Business Office throughout the week prior to classes and then weekly throughout the semester. Please use your myWNC account to monitor the progress of your financial aid disbursement and refund.
- 8. WNC Financial Assistance Office will begin disbursing <u>Student Loans (including Parent Plus Loans)</u> the third week of the semester. Refunds will be sent from the Business Office weekly throughout the semester. Please use your myWNC account to monitor the progress of your financial aid disbursement and refund.
- **9.** In order to maintain your financial aid eligibility, you must meet the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress standards. It is your responsibility to review and understand the Satisfactory Academic Progress policy.
- **10.** WNC Financial Assistance utilizes a Financial Aid Census Date. Your enrollment level will be locked at midnight on the 5th day of the semester. Additionally, you are required to be academically active in all of your courses by the Financial Aid Census date. Failure to be active could have implication on your federal aid. PELL	You have been awarded a Federal Pell Grant. Your award amount is projected at a full time enrollment level. Prior to disbursing aid, the college will check the number of financial aid eligible credits you are attempting to determine your level of enrollment (Full Time= 12 or more credits; Three quarter time = 9-11 credits; Half time = 6-8; Less than half-time = less than 6 credits). Your grant will be disbursed based on your actual level of enrollment in financial aid eligible credits.

CAEG

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Trump on March 27th, 2020. The CARES Act includes emergency grant funding to assist qualifying students with expenses related to disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19.

You have received an emergency grant payment under the federal CARES Act to assist with expenses related to disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus pandemic. Based on the guidance from the US Department of Education, the college has developed a formula to identify students who have had a significant disruption to their education and related expenses. If you received this award without applying, you were identified as a student who was forced to move to an online learning environment in one or more courses, you had completed a 2019-2020 FAFSA, and demonstrated eligibility for federal assistance. Award amounts are determined using your Expected Family Contribution (determined by your FAFSA) and Spring 2020 enrollment level. Award amounts range from \$100-\$1000, using a tiered awarding structure.

Students who are not awarded automatically are required to apply for CARES Act funds at https://www.wnc.edu/financial/types-of-aid/#CARESact. If you received this award after using the CARES Act Emergency Grant application, the college used your application, Expected Family Contribution and enrollment level to determine your award amount.

CARES Act Emergency Grant Awards are not included as aid towards meeting your

Cost of Attendance for 2019-2020, are not renewable for future award years, and will not be listed on your 1098T tax documents.
